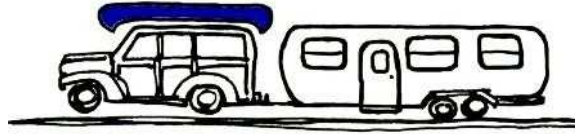

Camper Packing List

When packing for camp please keep in mind two important things: Laundry will be done weekly and you will be limited to packing ALL your belongings in a duffel bag (no larger than 25 x 42 maximum size for airline baggage); your duffel bag is checked baggage. You also need a small backpack/daypack which will be carry-on luggage and used at camp for every day activities.

Please label ALL clothing and equipment brought to camp.

The majority of your time at camp is spent outdoors except for sleeping so comfortable, casual clothing is best suited for camp.

The weather varies from park to park in the summer. Daytime temperatures can vary widely from 70s or 80s to over 100 F. Nights can be as cool as 40s. The cabins have air conditioning and heat for comfortable sleeping.
